TERM CONTRACT FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE SCOTTISH TRUNK ROAD NETWORK – NORTH-WEST UNIT
A82 NORTH BALLACHULISH TO ONICH, NIGHTTIME ROAD CLOSURES WITH AMNESTIES INFORMATION LETTER

BEAR Scotland, on behalf of Transport Scotland, will be undertaking essential carriageway resurfacing works on the A82 between North Ballachulish and Onich. Please find enclosed a location plan, which details the work extents.

Due to the nature of the works, it will be necessary to close the A82 trunk road in both directions each night from the evening of Sunday 3rd March to the morning of Friday 29th March, a total of 20 Nights, to ensure the safety of our workforce and members of the public, which is of paramount importance. No work will be undertaken on Friday or Saturday nights. The road will be closed each night between 19:00pm to 06:00am, amnesty periods will be in place where work on site will be temporarily suspended and vehicles will then be escorted through site, which will operate at the following times: 8pm, 9pm till 9:30pm, 10:30pm, 11:30pm, 1am and 3am.

Residents and businesses wishing to leave their property may do so, however we ask that residents wait at their junctions for assistance. A sign with a contact number will be placed at each junction that is affected. Regrettably, residents entering properties within the closed section must wait for hourly amnesty alongside all other vehicles.

The noisiest of operations e.g. removing the existing carriageway and use of jackhammers will cease at 11pm each night to reduce disruption to the local community.

The road closure and convoy systems will be removed out-with working hours, however a 30mph speed limit and warning signs will remain in place, as traffic will be travelling over a temporary road surface.

Access through the works site for emergency services will be always maintained.

We understand that road closures of this nature will be disruptive and have planned the works overnight when traffic flows are lower, to reduce the impact of the works. BEAR Scotland and Transport Scotland wish to thank the local community in advance for their patience during these essential works.
